Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 48 dated 18.03.2019 registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that alleged 1395 intoxicant tablets were recovered from the ground and not from the petitioner, thus not being in conscious possession, it is debatable before trial Court.

On the instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, learned State counsel states that out of 10 prosecution witnesses, only 1 witnesses has been examined.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
