Pursuant to the order dated 6.11.2019, an affidavit of Shri Balwan Singh, Superintendent of Police, Vigilance, HPUs, Gurugram, has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel, a copy of which has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner and is therefore ordered to be taken on record.

Learned State counsel points to paragraph 18 of the affidavit, wherein it has been stated that the petitioner has not been found to be accused in any of the other 7 FIRs registered and as such he was being got discharged from the concerned Court, which had rejected his anticipatory bail earlier (learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad).

It has also been stated by the SP that a departmental enquiry had been initiated against one ASI Babu Lal for negligence in performing his duties.

On the ground that there was negligence by officials of the

Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam also, it has further been stated in the affidavit of the SP that a letter has been written to the Superintending Engineer concerned, to place them under suspension and to get an enquiry conducted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that therefore, the petitioner no longer wishes to pursue this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
