On 19.9.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.7615 of 23.06.2017, registered under Sections 135, 151 of the Electricity Act, 2003, at Police Station I & P Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is neither owner nor in possession of the premises in which theft of electricity is alleged. He submits that the petitioner is sought to be implicated merely because the petitioner had received notice which was served by the Electricity Supply Company.

Notice of motion for 05.11.2019.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Anmol Malik, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Let a copy of the petition be handed over to him during the course of day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Babu Lal has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 19.9.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
