Applicant Mandip Kaur, aged about 31 years, estranged wife of respondent Arminder Singh, presently residing separately at Village Khokhar, Tehsil & District Gurdaspur, by way of filing the present application, seeks transfer of divorce petition, filed by her husband, respondent No.1 against her having title 'Arminder Singh Vs. Mandip Kaur and another' pending in the Court of Addl. District Judge, SAS Nagar (Mohali) to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Gurdaspur.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant besides going through the record.

A perusal of the copy of divorce petition attached with the application goes to show that there are grave and serious allegations of adultery against the present applicant and Amir Ali Khan with whom, the applicant is allegedly having illicit relations, has also been impleaded as respondent No.2 in the divorce petition. With such type

of allegations, the request of the applicant for transfer of the divorce petition cannot be accepted. The same is accordingly declined and the application being without any merit stands dismissed.
