The instant petition has been filed praying for a Mandamus for directing the official respondents to take necessary steps for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.5 to 8.

Counsel has been heard at length and case paper book has been perused.

As per pleadings on record, petitioner no.1, who is stated to be 31 years of age was married to respondent no.5 in the year 2010. Out of the wedlock two children have been born. She has now chosen to leave her matrimonial home and is in a live-in relationship with petitioner no.2.

The minor children have been left to be looked after by the father/respondent no.5.

This Court, under no circumstances can approve of the relationship/liaison between the petitioners.

Even otherwise, pleadings on record are wholly insufficient to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

No intervention is called for.

Petition is dismissed.
