Application has been filed for bringing on record the legal heirs of deceased original appellant Mahavir. It is stated that the said appellant had expired on 30.01.2006 during the pendency of the reference petition, leaving behind his legal heirs as appellant Nos.2 to 6, who are stated to be the only legal heirs of deceased appellant.

Accordingly, in view of the averments made in the

application, duly supported by affidavit of Gopal Yadav son of deceased-appellant, same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. Legal heirs-appellant Nos.2 to 6 are brought on record and permitted to pursue the present litigation only. It is made clear that the present order will not be liable to be taken into consideration in any other set of proceedings.
