TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA J.(Oral)

As per pleadings on record brother of the petitioner was married to the daughter of respondent No.4 and sister of respondent No.5 in the year 2018. Counsel submits that on account of some matrimonial dispute inter-se the parties the petitioner who is an unmarried lady is being unnecessarily harassed and being called repeatedly by respondent No.3 i.e. SHO Police Station NRI, Chandigarh Road, Ludhiana.

Counsel would argue that there are no allegations against the present petitioner and she is being hounded only for the reasons that her brother is married to the daughter of respondent No.4 and who has himself been a member of the police force.

In the light of short grievance raised and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, as regards her grievance/harassment.

In the eventuality of any such application, being filed,

respondent No.2, would be obligated to have the matter examined and thereafter to take steps as deemed fit and warranted in accordance with law.
