Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.69 dated 07.04.2018 under Sections 325, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 30.01.2019 passed by the trial Court, the petitioner could not furnish the bail/surety bonds, as he could not arrange the surety for him and on that pretext, his anticipatory bail application was dismissed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda. It is further submitted that all the offences are bailable and the petitioner is ready to furnish the bail/surety bonds before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of and the petitioner

is granted the concession of anticipatory bail till 15.10.2019 to enable him to furnish the bail/surety bonds before the trial Court.
