The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.106 dated 10.08.2019, registered under Section 409 IPC at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The operative part of the order dated 23.09.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that without conducting a proper enquiry as per the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, the impugned FIR has been registered.

Notice of motion for 14.10.2019....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 23.09.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from Ved Parkash,

has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
