The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 126 dated 24.8.2019 registered under Section 295-A, 355 IPC at Police Station City-1 Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 20.9.2019, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that with regard to the management of the temple, a civil suit was already pending, which stands decreed in favour of the accused party and even as per the own case of the complainant, number of times, meetings were held at the level of District Administration.

Notice of motion for 14.10.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 20.9.2019, have already joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 20.9.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
