ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 26 dated 20.02.2019, under Sections 379-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail by the trial Court and as he could not appear before the trial Court on 13.08.2019 due to call for Punjab 'bandh', his bail was cancelled. He also contends that the petitioner is 19 years of age and he is not involved in any other case. He undertakes that the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent himself except with the prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 20.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and in the event of his doing so, he was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 16.10.2019 and has been released on interim bail.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for petitioner, the order dated 20.09.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
