This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 247 dated 17.07.2018, registered under Sections 323, 307, 34 of the IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Jind Sadar, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 09.08.2018 and after the submission of challan and framing of charges, a compromise has been effected between the parties and in pursuance thereof, three prosecution witnesses, including the father of injured Ram Prasad, have not supported the prosecution version and they have been declared hostile.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satish Kumar and on the basis of the custody certificate filed today in Court, has not disputed the factual position and submitted that out of total 24 prosecution witnesses, 03 witnesses have been examined so far.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 09.08.2018; a compromise has been effected between the parties and also in view of the fact that conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
