RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):

1. Through this petition, the petitioner has sought for grant of emergency parole for four weeks for marriage of his sister namely Prabhjot Kaur, fixed for 30.09.2019.

2. The petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo life imprisonment under Sections 302/392/394/34 IPC in case FIR No.240 dated 08.06.2016 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar.

3. Reply has been filed by learned State counsel, in which it has been verified that the marriage of the sister of the petitioner is fixed for 30.09.2019. The petitioner has previously availed parole leave peacefully and surrendered back in jail in time. The Superintendent, Central Jail, Amrtisar, by way of this affidavit, has recommended parole to the petitioner. Copy of the reply is taken on record.

4. In view of the response, this petition is allowed. The petitioner is allowed the benefit of emergency parole for a period of

three weeks from the date of release to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate concerned, who is further directed to impose such conditions as are required to secure the presence of the petitioner in jail after the period of parole, is over and done with.
