On 27.09.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.235, dated 22.07.2019, registered under Sections 406/420/506/34 IPC, at Police Station Arya Nagar Rohtak, District Rohtak.

On 20.09.2019, learned counsel for the State of Haryana was handed over a copy of the petition and requested to assist after getting complete information.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has no role as his wife had sold the plot to the first informant through a registered sale deed. He submits that, in fact, no criminal case is made out against the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 27.11.2019.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

State of Haryana is also called upon to file affidavit clarifying the fact and situation on the next date of hearing.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, who is present in Court, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 27.09.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
