On 20.09.2019, following order was passed:-

“Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 100 dated 19.06.2019, registered under Sections 323, 325, 307, 341, 506 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station PAU, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned senior counsel submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, accused Bhinder Birmi, along with three other co-accused with muffled face, has caused injuries to the complainant.

Learned senior counsel further submits that after all the four accused persons stood arrested, the petitioner is involved in the present FIR, on the basis of some disclosure, after a period of three months.

Learned senior counsel further submits that even as

per the version in the FIR, the petitioner was not present at the spot.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Prem Lal, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 20.09.2019 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
