The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 326 dated 28.08.2018 under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station City Dadri.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had furnished forged documents while appearing for recruitment in the Indian Army. He also contends that the petitioner was not selected and did not derive any benefit whatsoever from the alleged documents furnished by him. The petitioner is not involved in any other case. He further contends that similarly situated co-accused namely, Vijay has been granted anticipatory bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-20887 of 2019 on 26.08.2019.

This Court, by order dated 20.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Harsh Kumar states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 20.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
