ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.170, dated 14.05.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468. 419, 471 and 120 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Khedki Daula, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that co-accused hired Scorpio car from the complainant by submitting forged documents in the name of Sagar and Subhash. The petitioner has been arraigned as an accused because he was found travelling in that vehicle. He contends that the petitioner is 19 years old and is in custody for over 07 months. He also contends that the petitioner was earlier falsely implicated in another case while he was a juvenile and was granted bail. All the witnesses in that case have resiled. He also contends that there is no allegation that the vehicle was used for any criminal activity.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Harmesh states that none out of 19 prosecution witnesses has been examined so far. He also contends that the petitioner is involved in another case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 19 years old, he is in custody for over 07 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
