This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to release the grant under Charan Shoo Scheme for commemoration of 550th Birthday of Shri Guru Nanak Dev Ji.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3- Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation dated 02.08.2019 (Annexure P-13) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl. AG Punjab, in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation dated 02.08.2019 (Annexure P-13) in accordance with

law within one week from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to it, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to it, within a period of one week thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter, in accordance with law.
