Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect his life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 9.

Counsel submits that petitioner was married to Ritu daughter of Jagdish/respondent No.4 herein.

However the matrimonial alliance did not work out and the petitioner has already instituted a divorce petition which is pending.

Pleadings on record are wholly insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

The instant petition would only be seen as a fall out of matrimonial dispute.

No intervention in the matter is called for.

Petition dismissed.
