Though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is very difficult to believe that the petitioner ran away from the spot in the presence of four police officials (as per the case of the investigating agency), upon query to him as to how the vehicle which admittedly the petitioner has purchased (though with the registration thereof not stated to be in his name), came into the possession of the police, there is no reply coming forthwith.

That being so, I see no ground to entertain this petition, which is consequently dismissed.

However, nothing observed herein above shall be taken to be a comment on the merits of the case, which would, naturally, go as per investigation and evidence led in the trial (if it comes to that stage).

Further, upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and filing any application for bail under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., that would be decided on its own merits.
