Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for directing the respondent authorities to issue in his favour a Passport.

Prima facie the prayer made in the petition is not well founded. Placed on record at Annexure P-2 is a communication issued by the Regional Passport Office, Amritsar dated 15.7.2019 in the nature of a clarification sought from the petitioner contemplating impounding of the Passport already issued to him.

Counsel is not even in a position to apprise this Court as to whether he has filed any reply to the clarification sought vide communication dated 15.7.2019 (Annexure P-2).

The prayer for issuance of a Passport as raised in the instant petition cannot survive as the communication dated 15.7.2019 (Annexure P-2) would itself reveal that petitioner is already a Passport holder and the concerned passport authorities are contemplating impounding of the same.

In the considered view of this Court the instant petition is wholly misconceived and is dismissed.
