Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though there is substantial compliance of direction of this Court, however, certain payments have yet not been credited.

Learned state counsel submits that pursuant to order dated 25.11.2019, the matter was looked into and three officials namely Mr.Kashmiri Lal, Mr.Pushpinder Kumar, Assistants, concerned Superintendent Mr. Vikas Kumar and Mr. Vikas Singh and Rajeev Gupta, Executive Engineers have been proceeded against for fixing responsibility.

It is further contended that the proceedings initiated would be taken to its logical end.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of directing the respondents that unpaid retiral benefits be credited to the account of the petitioners within eight weeks from today. It is clarified that the petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case grievance still survives.
