The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.431 dated 26.07.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 341 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Sections 379-B and 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Quilla Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that earlier the petitioner had been granted anticipatory bail by the trial Court. However, after 27 days of the occurrence and without obtaining any medical opinion, Sections 379-B and 307 IPC were added and the police moved an application for cancellation of the petitioner's bail which was allowed by the trial Court. He also contends that three co-accused have been granted regular bail and the injuries on the person of injured Vicky are on non-vital parts. He further contends that even the FIR was lodged after two days of the incident.

This Court, by the order dated 20.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balwan Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 20.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
