In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that even though the petitioner was never allotted any Government Accommodation still he was not given the benefit of HRA after June, 2005 upto his retirement on 30.04.2017.

The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the benefit of House Rent Allowance, which was not released to the petitioner from June, 2005 onwards till the retirement, forthwith.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 07.03.2019 (Annexure P-3) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in

the legal notice dated 07.03.2019 (Annexure P-3), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 07.03.2019 (Annexure P-3), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
