The petitioner prays for concession of regular bail in FIR No.18 dated 30.01.2015, registered under Sections 21, 22 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar City.

Recovery from the petitioner is of commercial quantity. Petitioner was granted interim bail awaiting for report of the Forensic Science Laboratory. On completion of the investigations, challan was presented on 20.11.2017. Notices were issued. Efforts were made to secure the presence of the petitioner. However, petitioner did not appear, forcing the Court to declare him as a proclaimed offender. Petitioner was arrested on 23.11.2018. Petitioner is also involved in another criminal case under the NDPS Act, 1985.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, in the considered view of this Court, the petitioner does not deserve concession of bail. However, trial Court is requested to expedite the decision in the trial.
