ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0066 dated 09.07.2019, under Sections 326, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the right elbow of the complainant and there is a delay of eight days in registering the FIR. He also contends that the complainant himself has stated in the FIR that the respectables of the village tried to effect compromise, but the same could not succeed. He further contends that the petitioner is ready to compromise the matter with the complainant.

This Court, by the order dated 23.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer,

subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 23.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
