ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 99 dated 03.08.2019, under Sections 452, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No. 8, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is a counter-blast to the complaint lodged by the petitioner wherein he had received several injuries on 28.07.2019. He has referred to the copy of his MLR at Annexure P2. However, no action was taken on the complaint of the petitioner as the petitioner has matrimonial dispute with his wife and his father-in-law is a serving Assistant Sub-Inspector in Punjab police. He also contends that the injuries, which are attributed to the petitioner, are simple in nature.

This Court, by the order dated 23.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Jaswinder Pal, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 23.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
