HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.43 dated 25.02.2014 under Sections 399/402 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Tanda, Hoshiarpur.

It is stated that the petitioner was released on bail by the trial Court on 16.04.2014. Thereafter, he was regularly appearing before the trial Court. Charges have been framed on 28.09.2017. However, on 04.06.2019, the petitioner could not appear before the Court due to un-avoidable circumstances and accordingly, his bail bonds and surety bonds were cancelled. He was summoned through non-bailable warrants. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that his non-appearance was not intentional. In fact a wrong date was noted by him which resulted his non-appearance. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender

before the trial Court and face trial. He states that the case is fixed before the trial Court on 18.11.2019 and the petitioner may appear before the trial Court on 18.11.2019.

The petitioner may appear before the learned trial Court on or before 18.11.2019. On his appearance, the trial Court shall release him on bail to its satisfaction. He shall continue to appear before the learned Court without any default.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
