Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that three candidates belonging to BC-B category, after the finalization of the result, did not join and the petitioner being in the waiting list at No.1, is entitled for appointment and in this regard has already served legal notice dated 11.06.2019 (Annexure P-8). The petitioner would be satisfied if the same may be decided within some reasonable time.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merit of the case or commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 11.06.2019 (Annexure P-8) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case the claim of the petitioner is to be accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to her, in accordance with law and if the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted, then a well reasoned and speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

It is made clear that in case the legal notice is not decided within two months, there shall be costs of ₹ 25,000/- to be paid to the petitioner.
