For the reasons recorded in the application, delay of 27 days in filing the present appeal is condoned.

Application stands disposed of.

Main case

The present appeal has been filed by the claimants being the mother, unmarried sisters and brother of deceased Kulwinder Singh, who died in a road side accident on 20.06.2014 on the ground that the compensation awarded to them is on the lower side.

After going through the award dated 13.09.2017 it is clear that the compensation has been given as per the law prevalent at that time. The benefit of 50% future prospects has been added and unmarried sisters have also been given Rs. 1 lac each towards loss of love and affection and Rs. 25,000/- have been given towards last rites. No further modification can be done as per the

judgments passed in case of *National Insurance Company Limited v. Pranay Sethi*, (2017)16 SCC 680, and *Magma General Insurance Company Ltd., Vs. Nanu Ram @ Chuhru Ram & ors.*, 2018(4) RCR(Civil) 333.

Appeal is dismissed.
