Petitioners are seeking indulgence of this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to adjust/re-engage the petitioners against the vacant work load/posts (Annexure P-10) in view of order dated 19.01.2017 and further writ of mandamus directing the respondents in case the regularization policy (Annexure P-8) be upheld, the claim of petitioners be considered within three months thereafter. In this regard, had submitted legal notice (Annexure P-13), but there is no adherence thereto.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that they will be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider the legal notice (Annexure P-13) in view of order dated 19.01.2017 (Annexure P-6), within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the

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petitioners, I deem it appropriate to direct the respondents to consider the legal notice (Annexure P-13) in view of order dated 19.01.2017 (Annexure P-6), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and shall pass a speaking order thereon after affording opportunity of hearing to petitioners and taking into consideration judicial precedents as well, failing which, the respondents shall be liable to pay costs of ₹25,000/- to the petitioners.

This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioners to run from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
