The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.129 dated 28.05.2019 registered under Sections 379-B, 323, 341, 506, 148, 149, 427 IPC at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, District Patiala.

The operative part of the order dated 23.09.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“...Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that on account of a sudden provocation, a fight has taken place....”

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 23.09.2019, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Suba Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the

petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 23.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
