1. Impugned herein is an order dated 22.04.2019(Annexure P-3) vide which the petitioner has been transferred from Oriental Bank of Commerce, Bathinda Branch to Varanasi(Uttar Pradesh).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been transferred in gross violation of transfer policy dated 19.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) which provides for posting of female employee at a place which is near to the place of posting of her husband. It is stated that, in the premise, the petitioner submitted a representation dated 10.05.2019 (Annexure P-4), but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. A.K. Ahuja, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass a speaking order by objectively considering the contentions as raised representation dated 10.05.2019(Annexure P-4) along with the contents of the instant writ petition by treating the same as supplementary representation, in accordance with law.

6. Needful be done within a period of 30 days from receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Until a decision is taken by the respondents, operation of order dated 22.04.2019 (Annexure P-3), impugned herein, be kept in abeyance qua the petitioner as she is stated to be on medical leave and is yet to join work at Varanasi. In case any adverse order is passed, the same shall not be implemented for a period of fifteen days, in order to allow the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy qua the same.

8. Disposed of in above terms.
