This petition is filed to challenge the Scheme prepared under Section 20 of the East Punjab Holdings (Consolidation & Prevention of Fragmentation) Act, 1948 (for short “the Act”) which was alleged to have been confirmed vide order dated 25.05.2018.

In our considered opinion, the statutory remedy is available to the petitioner under Section 42 of the Act by filing a revision petition before the State Government against the confirmed scheme.

Faced with these observations, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to avail the aforesaid remedy in terms of Section 42 of the Act at the first instance.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Liberty granted.
