This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.1102 dated 04.11.2018 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 506 IPC at Police Station- Sirsa City, District Sirsa (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 01.06.2019 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 14.10.2019 had directed Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to determine as to whether any such like FIRs stand registered against the petitioners at any other police station and to that effect, an affidavit of a gazetted officer was ordered to be filed.

Today, in compliance with the said order, learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Aryan Chaudhary, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (HQ), Sirsa, District Sirsa on behalf of respondent No.1. The same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel states that during the investigation in the present case, no cognizable offence was found to have been committed by the persons named in the FIR and, therefore, the cancellation report has been prepared on 28.03.2019 and presented before the higher police officers for further action.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
