Learned counsel for the petitioner asserts that against the order of partition dated 12.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Talwara, District Hoshiarpur, petitioner had made an attempt to file a revision petition but the staff in the office of the Financial Commissioner, Punjab, have not accepted the said revision petition. Counsel states that he has himself approached the office of the Financial Commissioner, Punjab, but has not been successful.

Let the counsel for the petitioner now approach the office of the Financial Commissioner, Punjab, on **24.09.2019** at **10:00 AM** along with the revision petition, which may be entertained to the extent of filing and thereafter an independent order be passed by the Financial Commissioner, Punjab, in accordance with law either accepting the filing of the revision petition or may even reject it as not maintainable.

The writ petition stands disposed of with above observations.
