Challenge in this writ petition is to the order dated 06.09.2018 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab-respondent No.1, order dated 12.02.2013 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Patiala Division, Patiala and orders dated 03.05.2010 (Annexure P-1) and 11.08.2010 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Payal, whereby the mode of partition was proposed and subsequently finalised without deciding the objections submitted by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly brings it to the notice of the Court that challenge to these orders by one Shri Bhajan Singh, who was similarly placed as the petitioner and was a co-sharer, stands dismissed by this Court on 20.03.2019 i.e. *CWP No.7754 of 2019* titled as *Bhajan Singh Versus The Financial Commissioner Revenue, Punjab and others*, Review Application preferred wherein i.e. RA-CW No.303 of 2019 has also been dismissed on 17.09.2019.

3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed in same terms as in *CWP No.7754 of 2019* titled as *Bhajan Singh Versus The Financial Commissioner Revenue, Punjab and others* decided on 20.03.2019.
