CRM-M-29517 of 2018 filed by the petitioner was disposed of on 16.07.2018 with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar-Rural, to look into the prayer of the petitioner as regards protection of his life and liberty and to act in accordance with law. As the needful was not done, petitioner filed the present petition.

Learned State counsel has filed a short reply by way of an affidavit of Mr. Vikram Jeet Duggal, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar-Rural, same is taken on record. Copy handed over to the counsel for the petitioner.

It is pleaded that after looking into the allegation levelled in the complaint, FIR No. 184, dated 07.11.2019, under Sections 454, 380 of the Indian Penal Code 1860 has been registered at Police Station Gharinda, Amritsar Rural. It is further pleaded that ASI Yashpal Singh, No. 1103 and

ASI Harpal Singh, No.93 have been suspended, as they have kept the communication with them which resulted in delay in taking the appropriate action.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mohit Kumar, SHO, PS Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural, ensures that the inquiry marked against the erring officials would be taken into its logical end as expeditiously as possible.

In view of above, present petition is disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

Needless to add that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for the redressal of surviving grievance if any.
