Application has been filed for bringing on record the legal heirs of deceased respondents No.1 Smt. Bhagirthi and No.3 Rajbir. It is stated that the said respondents had expired on 07.01.2015 and 01.10.2011 respectively, leaving behind their legal heirs as mentioned in para No.2 of the application, who are stated to be the only legal heirs of deceased respondents. It is further stated that there are no other legal heirs of the deceased respondents except ones mentioned in para No.2 of the application.

Accordingly, in view of the averments made in the application, duly supported by affidavit of official, same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. Legal heirs as mentioned in the application are brought on record. It is made clear that the present order will not be liable to be taken

into consideration in any other set of proceedings. Amended memo of parties is taken on record. Office to tag the same at appropriate place.
