AMIT RAWAL, J (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to provide / give compassionate appointment to the petitioner no.2 Sachin Dev against the suitable post in consideration of his eligibility on account of death of Mahender Singh (Government employee). In this regard, had submitted representations dated 15.09.2017, 03.04.2018 and 23.12.2018 (Annexures P-7 to P-9), but there is no adherence thereto.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that he will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents, to consider the representations dated 15.09.2017, 03.04.2018 and 23.12.2018 (Annexures P-7 to P-9), within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioners, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent no.2 The Director General, Health Services Haryana, Sector 6, Panchkula to consider the representations dated 15.09.2017, 03.04.2018 and 23.12.2018 (Annexures P-7 to P-9), within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified

copy of this order and shall pass a speaking order thereon after affording opportunity of hearing to petitioners and taking into consideration judicial precedents as well, failing which, respondent no.2 shall be liable to pay costs of ₹ 25,000/- to petitioners.

This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioners to run from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition is disposed of with the above direction.
