ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 917 dated 27.08.2019, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Thanesar City, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the dispute between the petitioner and the complainant is civil in nature. He also contends that the petitioner is a bona fide purchaser of the property in the year 2015. He also contends that the complainant had also filed a civil suit for specific performance in the year 2015 for execution of the sale deed. He further contends that it is alleged by the complainant that co-accused Rajiv Kumar had entered into an agreement to sell with the complainant, but later on before execution of the sale deed he had sold the shop to the petitioner.

This Court, by the order dated 25.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-

interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Randhir, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 25.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
