The petition i.e. CRM-M No. 21597 of 2012, was filed in the year 2012 with a prayer to quash the criminal complaint No.38/1 dated 20.02.2009 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and for setting-aside the summoning order dated 20.05.2011 (Annexure P6) and further proceedings arising from the complaint whereas prayer in petition i.e. CRM-M No.33031 of 2015 is for initiating appropriate proceedings against the respondent for filing a false affidavit dated 02.03.2013.

The case remain pending for a considerable long time and on the last date of hearing, noticing the fact that no one is appearing from either of the party, the trial Court was directed to furnish the status of the trial.

The trial Court has submitted a report that a complaint was

withdrawn on 23.04.2018 on the basis of the compromise between the parties.

Considering the fact that after withdrawal of the complaint on 23.04.2018, the said fact was not informed to this Court and the case was adjourned on 02 occasions when nobody appears on behalf of the petitioners. Accordingly, these petitions are dismissed with a costs of Rs.20,000/- (Rs.10,000/- to be paid by the petitioners and Rs.10,000/- to be paid by the respondent).

The trial Court is directed to recover the costs of Rs.20,000/- from the petitioners and the respondent and deposit the same in the District Legal Services Authority, Ludhiana.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of other connected case.
