AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties and various orders, which have been passed in this case, what transpires is that the only payment which the respondents were required to make was payment of interest, which amount has been calculated and it is disbursed to them as per the additional affidavit of the Chief Engineer, Ranjit Sagar Dam Construction. Along with the said affidavit, there is a list of 436 employees of the petitioner -Union. The total amount which has been disbursed is ₹ 4,47,714/- as interest.

Counsel for the petitioner states that some of the employees have still not received the interest amount.

If that be so, let the said members of the petitioner – Union move an application to the Competent Authority for release of the amount

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of interest as detailed in Annexure R-1 attached along with the affidavit dated 06.10.2017, which shall be considered and decided by the Competent Authority within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of such application.

If the claim is found to be genuine, the same be released to them within a further period of four weeks.

With these observations/directions, the present writ petition is disposed of.
