[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing respondents to allow the petitioner to continue his stay in Gurudwara accommodation allotted to him.

[2] Stand of the respondents on the other hand is that the services of the petitioner were terminated on 31.03.2018 and that the accommodation allotted to him only on account of his having been appointed as temporary 'Granthi' in Gurudwara Sri Nada Sahib and that pursuant to termination of his services on 31.03.2018, he has no right to retain the premises.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P-4 dated 16.09.2019 but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to consider and decide the same.

[4] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is

disposed of by directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to consider and decide the representation, Annexure P-4 dated 16.09.2019 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Till such time the decision is taken, the petitioner shall not be dispossessed.
