Non-commercial quantity of Tramadol tablets is stated to have been recovered from the petitioner (as per the case of the investigating agency), on 26.07.2019, with immediately thereafter FIR No. 287 of 2019 having been instituted against him on the same date, the FIR in the present case being FIR No. 286.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has also put in 02 months of custody, with the trial still to effectively start and both the FIRs seen to be of the same date, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
