Darshan Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to official respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner from respondent Nos.3 to 10 as he has filed a criminal complaint against them.

During the course of argument, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that pursuant to the complaint, three accused were summoned and two of them are on bail whereas one accused is declared as proclaimed offender. The representation dated 17.08.2019 (Annexure P-2), does not reveal any kind of particulars much less of any threat as alleged by the petitioner, therefore, this Court does not find any reason to invoke inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Resultantly, petition is dismissed.
