At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that although the petitioner had approached respondent No.2 on 4.6.2019 for redress of his grievance as is the subject matter of the writ petition yet no representation in writing as such was submitted by the petitioner and that in the circumstances, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file a comprehensive representation before respondent No.2 and respondent No.2 be directed to consider and decide the same expeditiously on receipt since the petitioner has applied for compassionate appointment on account of death of his father and is required to complete formalities in respect thereto within two months.

2. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to submit a comprehensive representation to respondent No.2 within one week from the

date of receipt of certified copy of order. On receipt of the representation alongwith certified copy of the order, respondent No.2 would consider and decide the same in accordance with law preferably within a period of four weeks thereafter.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned directions.
