Learned counsel for the petitioner points to the orders passed in the case of two co-accused of the petitioner, i.e. Surinder Singh and Baljinder Singh @ Nona, by which they have been admitted to bail, with detailed reasons having been recorded by this Court (co-ordinate Bench), in the order passed in Surinder Singhs' case, i.e. CRM-M-30193-2019, decided on 24.07.2019.

It has been noticed in that order that there was a delay of almost 04 years and 09 months in lodging the FIR, with initially a DDR having been lodged by the son of the deceased to the effect that the deceased himself had consumed poison.

Though the petitioner is stated to be the prime accused in the FIR, with whom the deceased was living, however, in view of the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for the past one year, with 08 prosecution witnesses still to be examined, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or

against the petitioner, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon her furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
