Petitioner-Rinku Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0113 dated 09.09.2019 registered under Sections 61 of Excise Act at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

The FIR was registered on the secret information wherein it was informed that Rinku Singh, Makhan Singh both sons of Bhura Singh are involved in work of selling liquor. As per the information, a huge quantity of liquor was kept in their house. Acting upon the same, 108 bottles of country made liquor were recovered from the house of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was not present at the spot when the alleged recovery was effected.

On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh has opposed the bail application on the ground that the recovery was effected from the house of the petitioner who is involved in 12 number of similar cases.

In view of the above, no case is made out for grant of extra ordinary concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.
