

Bhagoti Devi and anr. Vs. Manjeet and ors.

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On 09.09.2019, on behalf of appellant No.2 and proforma respondent Nos.4 and 5, statement was made to accept ₹4,30,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect. Thus, a sum of ₹4,30,000/- (₹ Four Lac Thirty Thousand Only) is allowed to appellant No.2 and proforma respondent Nos.4 and 5 against the Insurance Company. As per the statement of learned counsel for appellant No.2 and proforma respondent Nos.4 and 5, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.2 and proforma respondent Nos.4 and 5 in equal shares.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the crossed – cheques for the enhanced amount of ₹4,30,000/- in the respective names of appellant No.2 and proforma respondent Nos.4 and 5, in equal shares, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 31.10.2019, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques

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to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company.

The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
